Dear President-Elect Biden:

As organizations representing immigrant families, health care access, children, people with disabilities, nutrition, public health, housing, and economic opportunity, we appreciate your commitment to reversal of the Trump administration's dangerous public charge regulations. These cruel rules are directly harming immigrants and their families and undermining our country's pandemic response. We urge you to begin work immediately after your inauguration, by issuing an Executive Order that includes directing agencies to rescind the public charge regulations and committing the White House to swift, bold and comprehensive policy and outreach strategies aimed at ensuring immigrants and their families feel safe in accessing public benefits and services.

The Department of Homeland Security implemented Trump's public charge policy on February 24, 2020. Since then, research has shown that the Trump public charge regulation has effectively denied millions in immigrant families the help they need, contributing to rising hunger, poverty, and unmet health care needs, even before the COVID-19 pandemic began. The Department of State adopted a similar policy that led to skyrocketing denials of immigrant visas and deepened the policy's dangerous "chilling effect." An immediate commitment to reverse these reckless policies would send a critical message to immigrant families that the federal government is not a threat.

Urgent action isn't just about symbolism — in fact, it's a matter of life and death. The pandemic has taken the heaviest toll on those already bearing the burdens of health disparity and economic marginalization resulting from centuries of institutional racism. According to the <u>U.S.</u> Centers for <u>Disease Control and Prevention</u>, the COVID-19 case rate, hospitalization rate, and death rate are all significantly higher for persons of color. And as both <u>clinicians</u> and <u>researchers</u> have documented, immigrants and their families face additional obstacles, including policies like public charge that discourage needed testing and care.

The Trump public charge policy also poses a significant threat to effective COVID-19 vaccine distribution. To the degree that immigrant families consider vaccination a potential threat to immigration status, vaccination efforts will suffer, prolonging the health crisis and delaying economic recovery.

That is why you must act with urgency. Immigrants must hear from the highest office in the land that they are again welcome and valued members of our society. A reference in your inaugural address or some other public statement during your first few days in office would provide critical

assurances. Those assurances would have even more effect backed by the launch of a robust public engagement campaign by federal agencies, offering clear and transparent information about the limitations of the Trump public charge policy as it concerns public programs. In addition, work to repeal and replace the public charge rules should begin immediately-during the transition, given the urgent need for change and the time-consuming nature of regulatory development. We know that it may take time to formally roll back the public charge regulation but taking these first steps, while work advances, can do much to begin thawing the policy's chilling effect and rebuilding trust.

We know you understand the danger posed by this policy and, again, appreciate your leadership in committing to its reversal. But the need is urgent, and time is not on our side. You must act quickly to set in motion the needed steps.

Thank you for your consideration and your leadership in building a nation where all families can thrive.
