<u>Public Charge Proposal Puts Millions at Risk, Advocates Warn - Protecting Immigrant</u>
 Families

Messages

- This proposal is about chaos and bias
 - Without the Biden regulation's guardrails, DHS can base public charge denials on any health or social services program the administration wants
 - Or on any personal traits like obesity or disability the administration dislikes
 - And, going beyond the 2019 Trump policy, it contemplates considering family members' health or social services use or family medical history
 - o It's a wealth test aimed at making lawful immigration available only to the rich
- The proposal is part of the broader assault on lawfully present immigrants, US citizens in immigrant families, and the communities that welcome them
 - OBBBA already makes even fewer lawfully present immigrants eligible for benefits
 - So most of the projected reduction in safety net program usage will likely come from US citizens – mostly children – in immigrant families
 - Like the 2019 Trump public charge policy, it uses chaos and threats to deter millions in immigrant families from using government services for which they qualify under federal law
 - And like the 2019 Trump policy, it threatens the nation's health and economic security
 - But in the context of the administration's reckless and lawless enforcement assault, the "chilling effect" could be even deeper
- It's also part of the administration's campaign to close doors to lawful immigration
 - Like \$100,000 visa fees and \$1M gold cards, or adding \$550 fees for work authorization and a 90% increase in TPS application fees
 - And like using "neighborhood checks" to harass naturalization applicants and their neighbors
 - And like a civics test that's more about MAGA ideology than US history
- Congress must act to protect the nation from this known threat
- State policymakers must raise your voices and demand action from their congressional delegations
